Admission Criteria

FACULTY: NURSING

A. ANM

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December the year in which admission is sought.
2. The maximum age for admission shall be 30 years.
3. The minimum education requirement shall be the passing of 12 years of schooling (10+2) recognized by CBSE, ICSE, SSSCE, HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination with English Core.
4. Students shall be medically fit.
5. Admission of the students shall be once in a year.
6. This college is not designed to frame male candidates hence no male candidates should apply for this course.
7. English is not mandatory during Intermediate.

B. GNM

1. Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission for Diploma in General Nursing Midwifery is 10+2 with English and passed with 40% at the qualifying examination from any recognized board.
2. Candidates are also eligible from state open school recognized by State Government & National Institute of open school (NIOS) recognized by Central government, However Science streams with that is preferable.
3. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks & vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council with 40% of marks.
4. Registered ANM with pass marks.

5. 3% Disability reservation with a disability of locomotors to the tune of 40-50% of the lower extremity.
6. 5% relaxed for SC/ST candidates.
7. Students should be medically fit.
8. Minimum age for admission will be 17 years and Max 35 years (as on 31 Dec. of that year). For ANM/LHV no age bar.
9. This college is not designed to frame male candidates hence no male candidates should apply for this course.
10. Admission of students shall be once in a year.

C. BASIC BSc. (NURSING)

1. Minimum age for admission will be 17 years on 31 December the year in which admission is sought
2. Minimum educational qualification is
3. 10+2 class passed with science (PCB) and English core/English elective with aggregate of 45% marks from recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or the equivalent board. Students appearing in 10+2 examination in science conducted by National Institute of Open School with 45% marks
4. Admission of students shall be once in a year.
5. Students shall be medically fit
6. In addition to the above, admission procedure can be laid down by concerned university (S.I.B.E, M.I.B.E, and C.M.A.I).

D. POST BASIC B.Sc. NURSING

1. Passed the higher secondary or senior secondary or intermediate or 10+2 or an equivalent examination recognized by the university.
2. Obtained a certificate in General nursing and Midwifery and registered as R.N.R.M with any state nurse's registration council.
3. Admission of students shall be once in a year.
4. Students shall be medically fit.
5. In addition to the above, admission procedure can be laid down by concerned university (S.I.B.E, M.I.B.E, and C.M.A.I)

E. M.Sc. (NURSING)

1. The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any state Nursing Registration Council.
 2. The minimum education requirements shall be the passing of:
 - a. B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
 3. The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
 4. Minimum One year of work experience after Basic B.Sc Nursing.
 5. Minimum One year of work experience prior or afterpost Basic B.Sc Nursing.
 6. Candidate shall be medically fit.
 7. 7.5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidate may be given.

FACULTY: PARAMEDICAL

All paramedical courses

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December the year in which admission is sought.
2. Admission of students shall be once in a year.
3. Students shall be medically fit
4. Minimum educational qualification is 10+2 class passed with science (PCB/PCM) with any recognized board/institute.
5. Reservation policy as per Uttar Pradesh State Government.

FACULTY: AGRICULTURE

(A) B.Sc. (Agriculture)

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December the year in which admission is sought.
2. Minimum educational qualification passed in 10+2 class or any equivalent examination with science with any recognized board/institute, students who have completed intermediate in Agriculture field also eligible to apply.
3. Reservation policy as per Uttar Pradesh State Government.

FACULTY: ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES

(A) B.Sc. (H) Biotechnology, B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc. Microbiology

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December the year in which admission is sought.
2. Minimum educational qualification passed in 10+2 class or any equivalent examination with science (PCB/PCM) with any recognized board/institute.
3. Reservation policy as per Uttar Pradesh State Government.

(B) M.Sc. Biotechnology:

1. Bachelor's Degree in either Physics, Biology Sciences or any other related discipline.

(C) M.Sc. Medical Biochemistry:

1. B.Sc. in either subject of Botany, Zoology, Nutrition, Food Sciences or any among Animal Science, Medicine and Veterinary Science from a reputed University.

(D) M.Sc. Medical Microbiology:

1. Bachelor's Degree in Sciences or any other related streams from reputed University.

(E) M.Sc. Medical Environment Science:

1. Bachelor's Degree from recognized University.

FACULTY: PHARMACY (AYURVEDA)

(A) B. Pharma

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December the year in which admission is sought.
2. Minimum educational qualification passed in 10+2 class or any equivalent examination with science (PCB/PCM) with any recognized board/institute.
3. Reservation policy as per Uttar Pradesh State Government and the Regulatory bodies.

(B) D.Pharma

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December the year in which admission is sought.
2. Minimum educational qualification passed in 10+2 class or any equivalent examination with science (PCB/PCM) with any recognized board/institute.
3. Reservation policy as per Uttar Pradesh State Government and the Regulatory bodies.
